This challenge made it difficult for us to supply our fosters with commonly used antibiotics that have proven essential in the recovery of the affected kitten(s), but we persevered and made any and all necessary corrections.

We also faced challenges with difficult fosters, which required us to adapt and be creative in finding solutions.

While these challenges were difficult, we are proud of how we responded and the progress we were able to make despite these obstacles. We believe that these challenges have made us stronger and more resilient as an organization.

As we look ahead to the upcoming year, we are excited about the opportunities and possibilities that lie ahead. We are committed to continuing our mission of saving as many kittens as possible under 6 weeks of age and making a positive impact on our community.
